NHWA AWARDS INFORMATION AND CRITERIA 2020

NHWA MALCOLM GRANT OAM VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD

This award recognises the outstanding contribution of an individual who has demonstrated on a continual basis support for the ideals of NHW and has freely given his or her time over an extended period of time.

Award Criteria

Applications must demonstrate how the nominee has contributed to 3 or more of the criteria:

- Reduce or prevent crime and disorder
- Reduce fear of crime
- Address issues relating to anti-social behaviour
- Build community spirit and cohesion
- Reassure members of the public
- Enhance partnership and/or working with other community groups
- Improve quality of life within local communities
- Create safer neighbourhoods
- Reporting of suspicious or criminal activity to police

The application must address the following:

- Summary of why the nominated person is considered worthy of receiving the NHWA Malcolm Grant OAM Volunteer Member of the Year Award.

NHWA POLICE COMMISSIONER'S AWARD

This award is presented by the Australian State/Territory or New Zealand Commissioner (or representative) recognising the outstanding service by an individual police employee through a consistent contribution to Neighbourhood Watch/Support.

Award Criteria

Applications must demonstrate how the nominee has contributed to 3 or more of the criteria:

- Reduce and/or prevention of crime and disorder
- Reduce fear of crime
- Address issues relating to anti-social behaviour
- Build community spirit and cohesion
- Reassure members of the public
- Enhance partnership and/or working with other community groups
- Improve quality of life and the local communities
- Create safer neighbourhoods

The application must address the following:

- Summary of why the nominated person is considered worthy of receiving the NHWA Police Commissioner's Award.

INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO ALL APPLICATIONS:

- The nomination must be received on the official application form.
- Applications must show evidence of contribution to NHW.
- Include information about how the nominated person upholds one or more of the values of Neighbourhood Watch Australasia (Leadership, Integrity, Support, Inclusiveness, Professionalism and Accountability).

Referees

Provide the names and contact details of two referees.

Supporting documentation

Provide any supporting materials such as newspaper articles, letters of appreciation, publicity photos or videos of the achievements in relation to key aspects of the nomination.

General Criteria

The Honours Committee will use the Award Criteria based on merit, in their assessment of nominations. Consideration will be given to the inclusion of referees and supporting documentation.

NHWA acknowledges that all jurisdictions across Australasia currently recognise the outstanding contributions made by Volunteers through their own individual awards system. NHWA welcomes nominations from all jurisdictions.
