Jannali and Mallee need lots of sleep to help them learn.

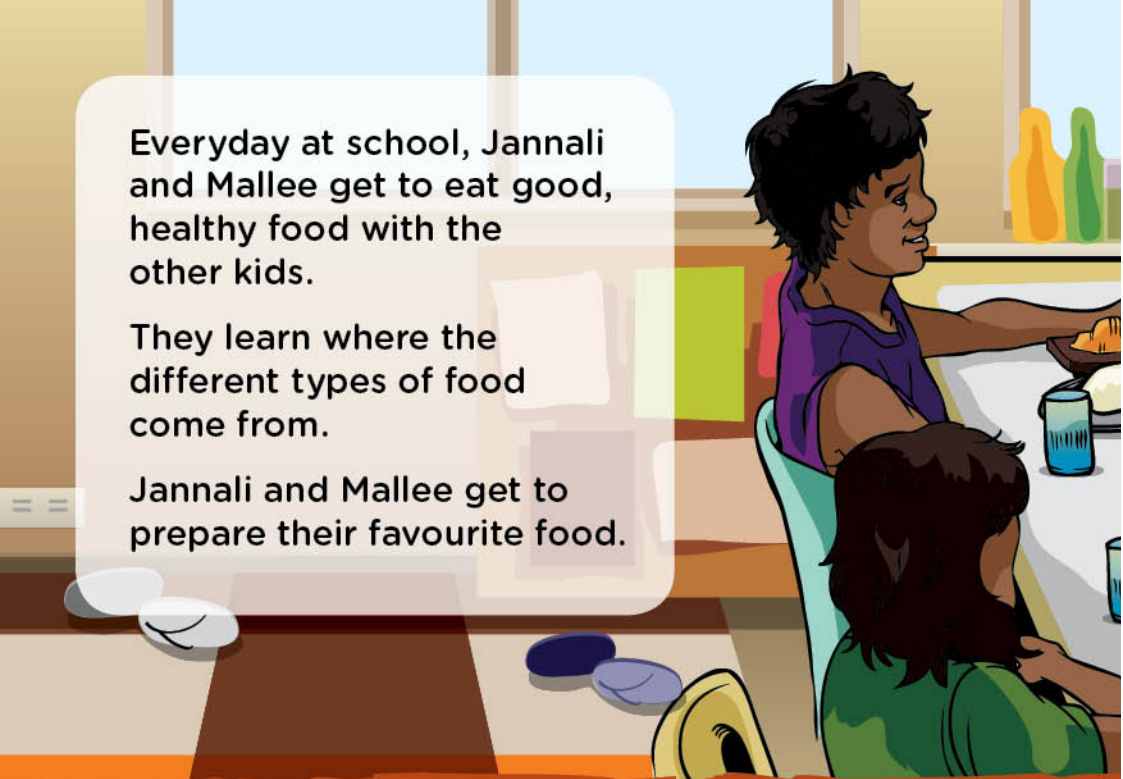
Jannali and Mallee like going to school because they get to learn important things and play with the other kids at school.

YOU DECIDE

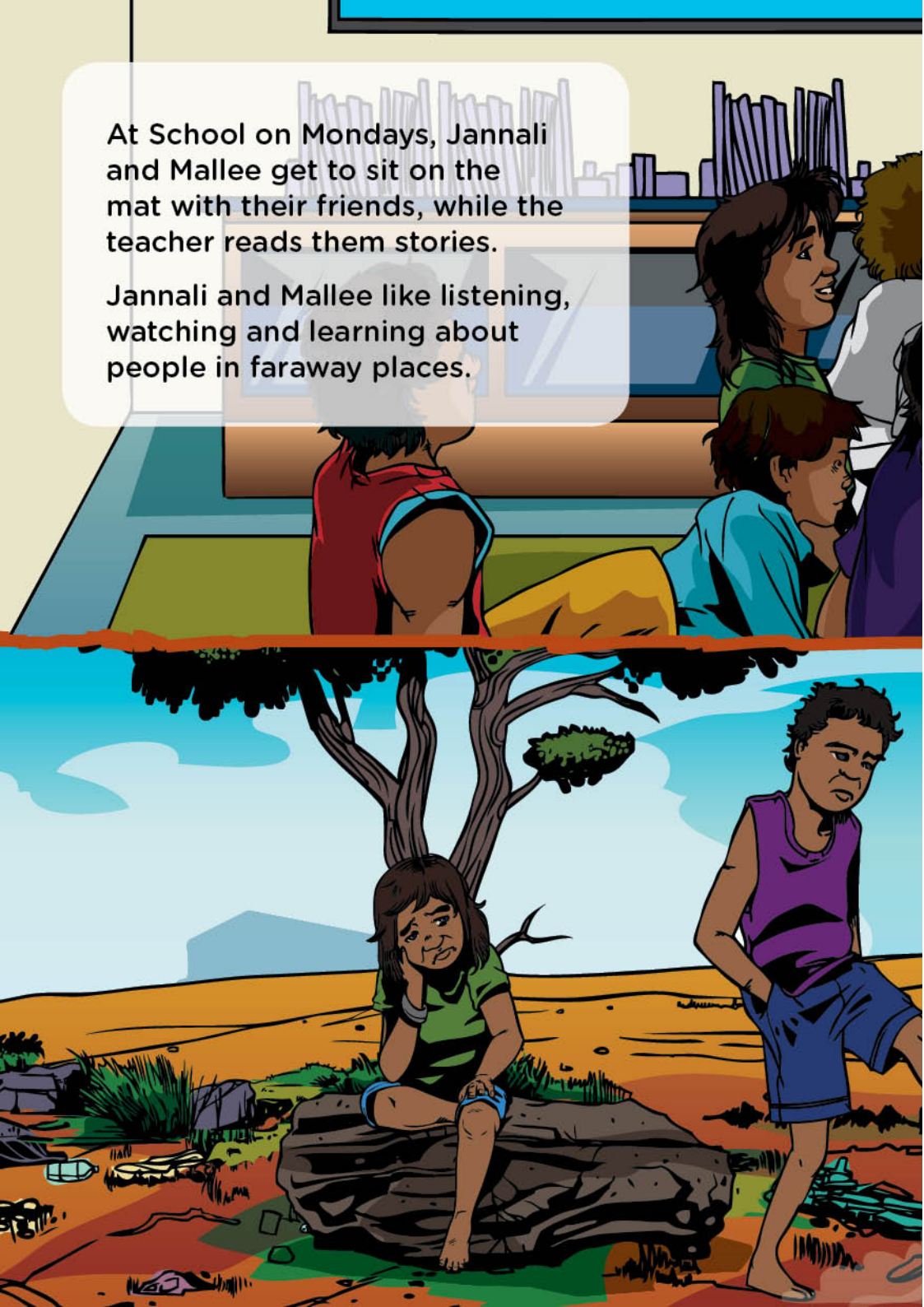


If Jannali and Mallee didn't go to school, they might feel very hungry.

Jannali and Mallee like listening, watching and learning about people in faraway places.

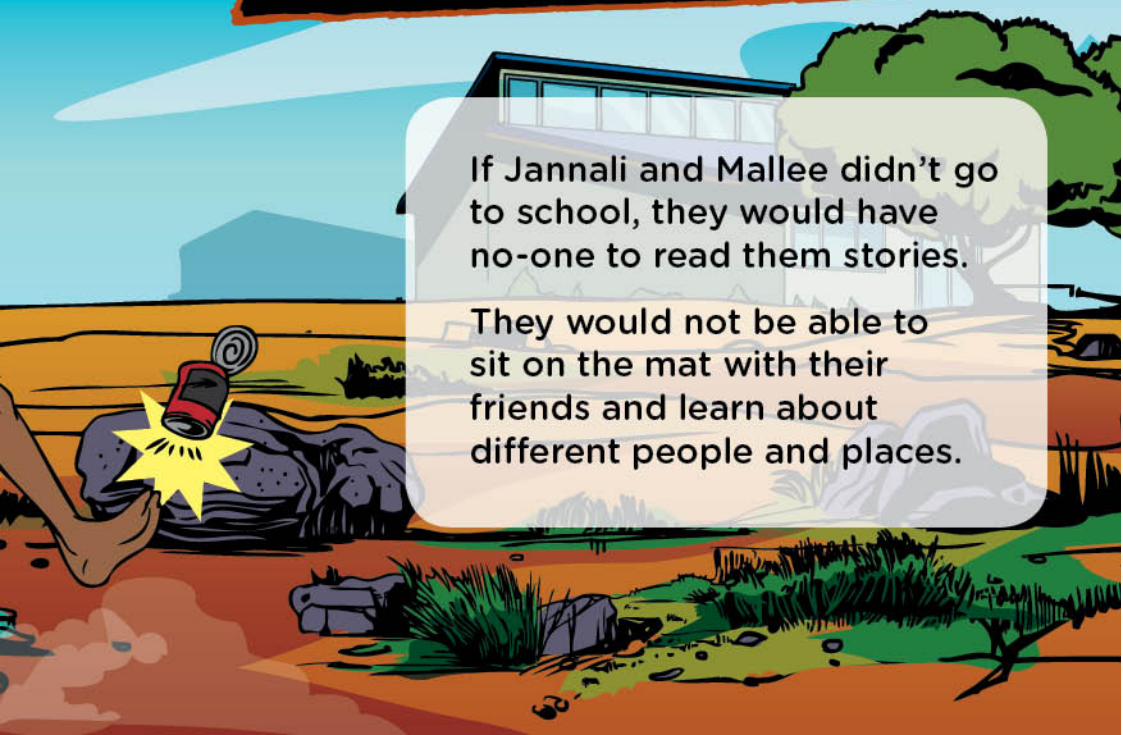




YOU DECIDE

They would not be able to sit on the mat with their friends and learn about different people and places.



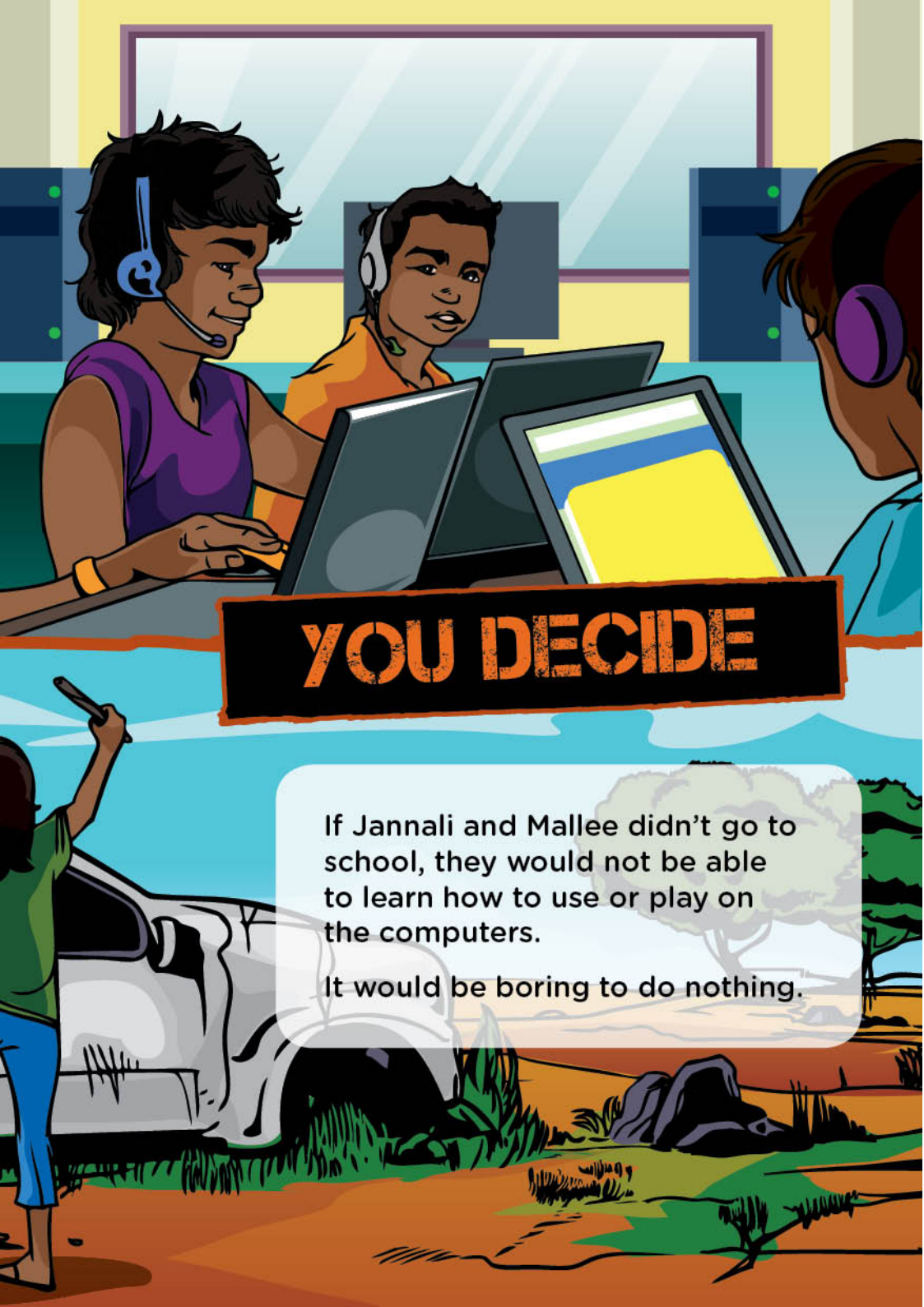
At School on Tuesdays,

If Jannali and Mallee didn't go to school, they would not be able to learn how to use or play on the computers.

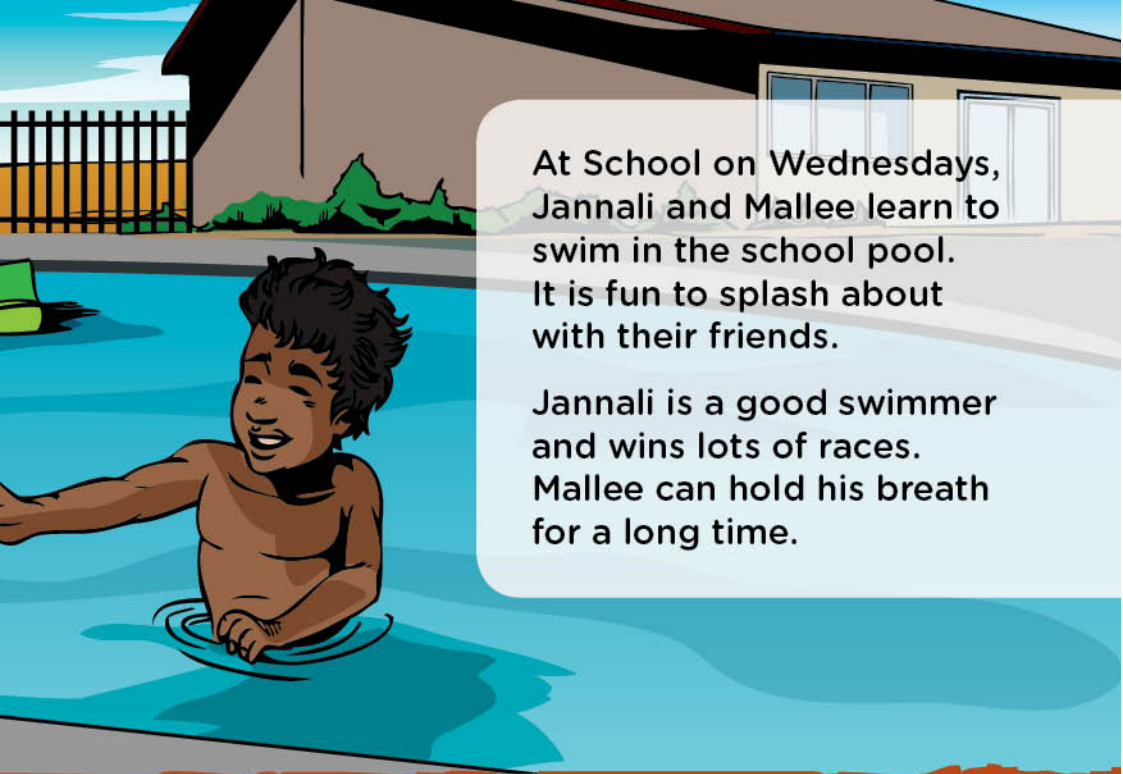
It would be boring to do nothing.

YOU DECIDE





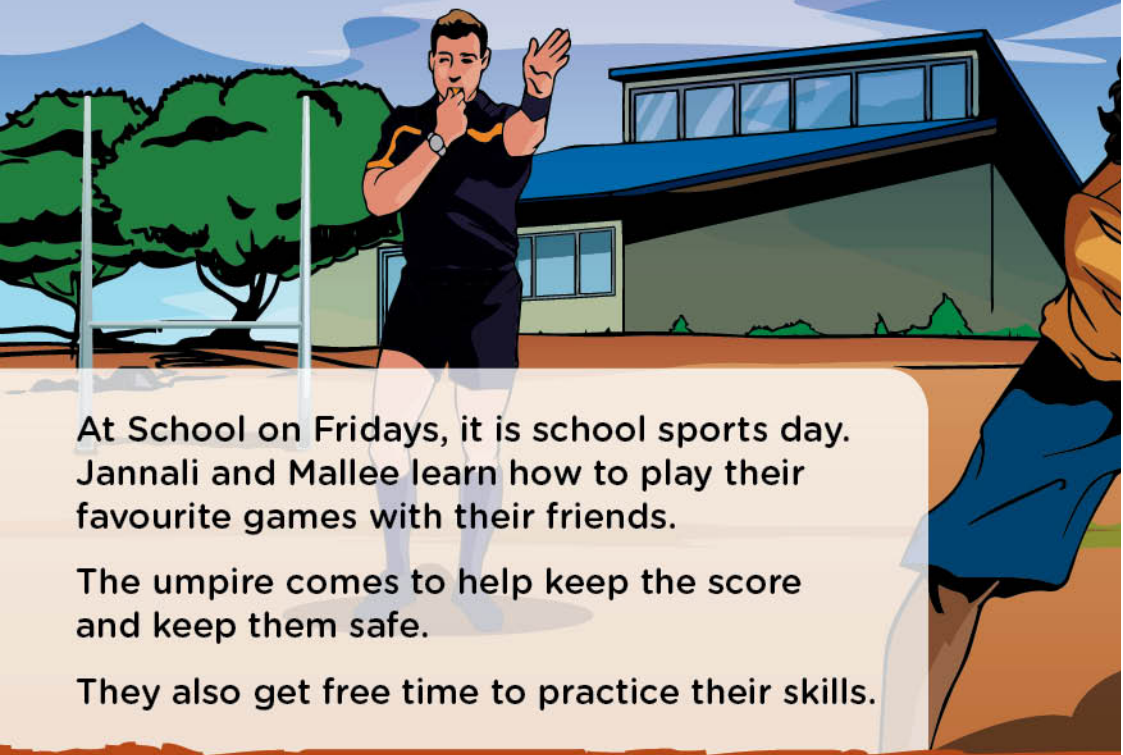
At School on Thursdays, Jannali and Mallee get to go on a school trip on the school bus. The school bus has lots of room and is a safe and fun way to travel.

It is important to buckle up with your seatbelt. Jannali and Mallee learn how to keep themselves and their friends safe by going to school.

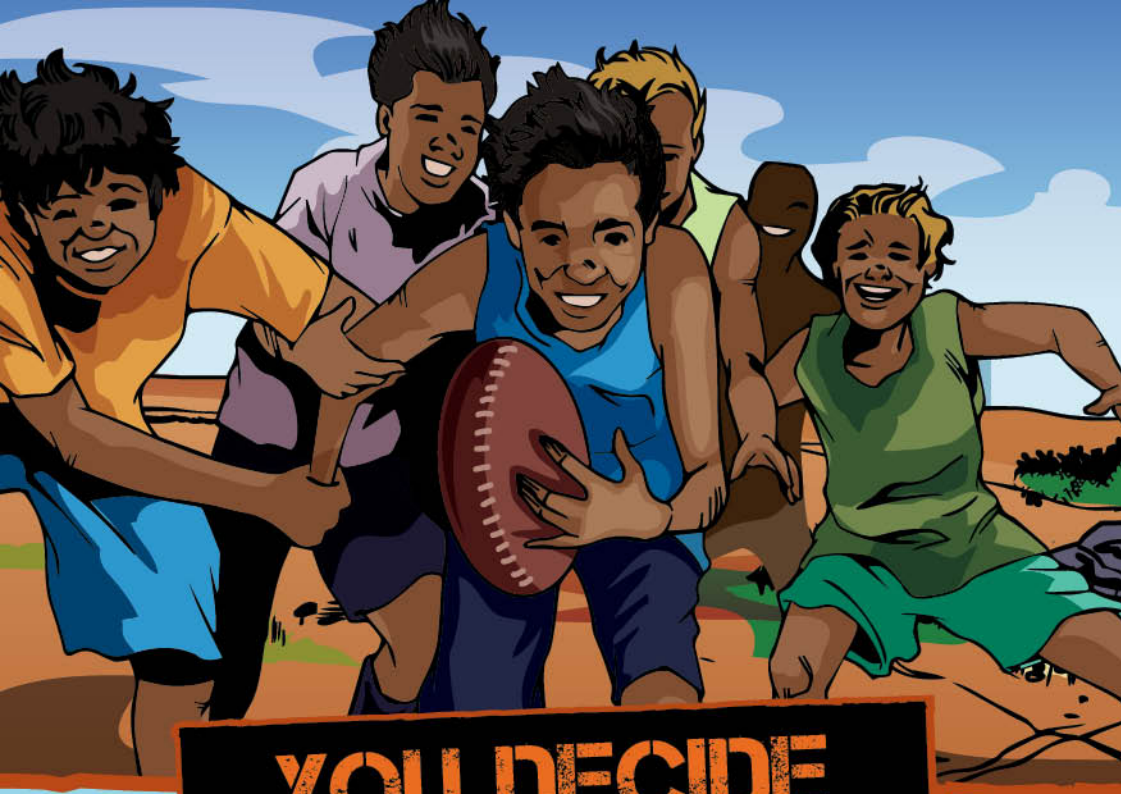


At School on Fridays, it is school sports day. Jannali and Mallee learn how to play their favourite games with their friends.

If Jannali and Mallee didn't go to school they might not learn how to be safe playing sports and they might get hurt.





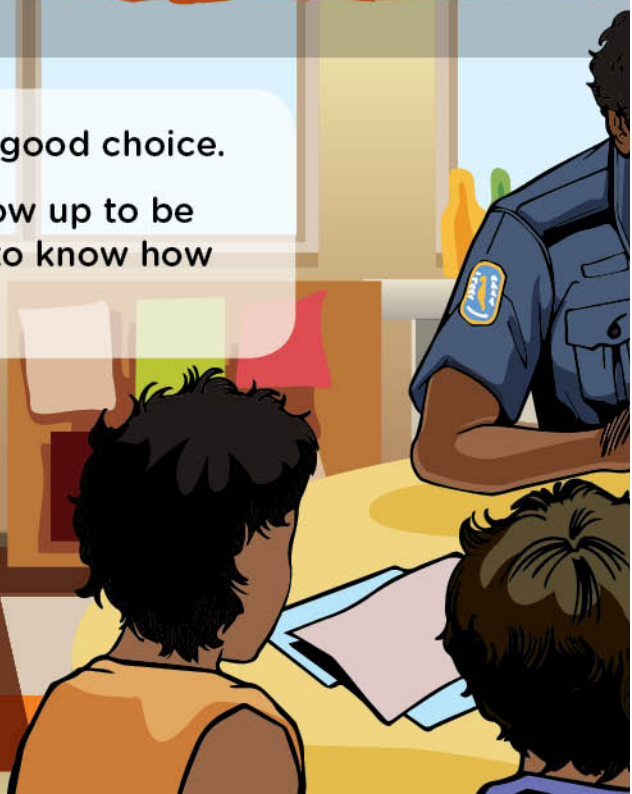
If you don't go to school you will get in trouble and feel bad.

It is important to make the right choice and go to school.



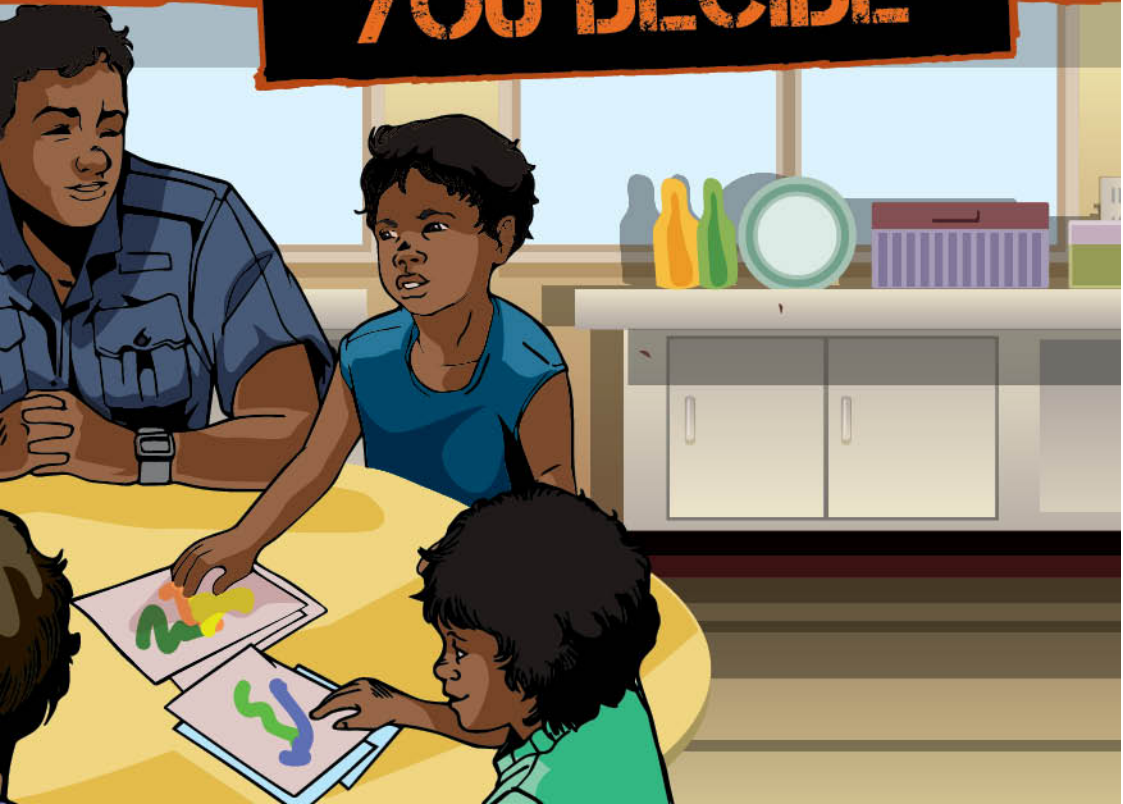
Going to school is a good choice.
