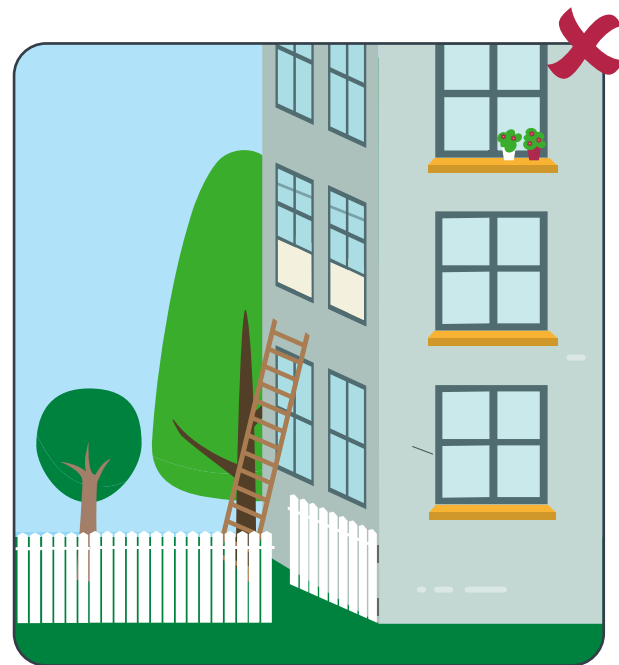




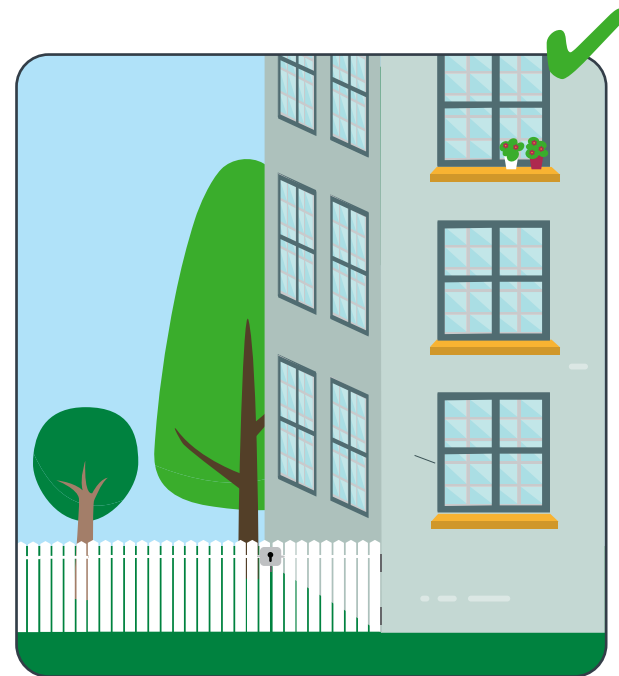
Do not leave any valuables in sight

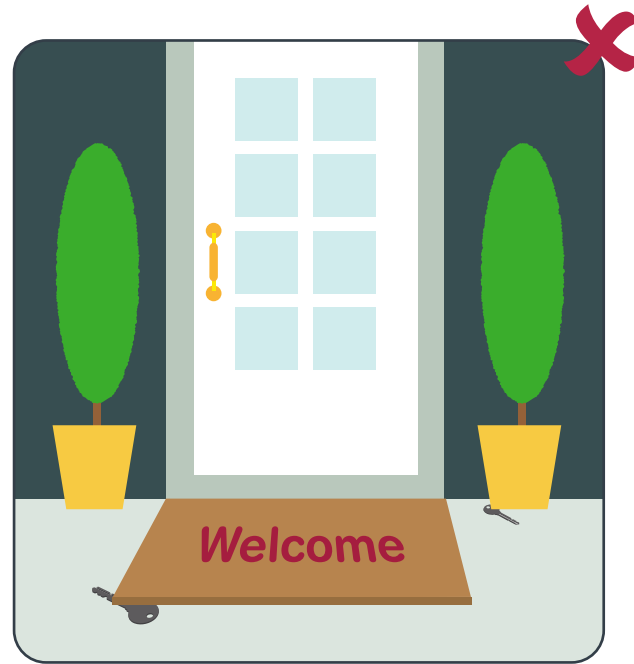
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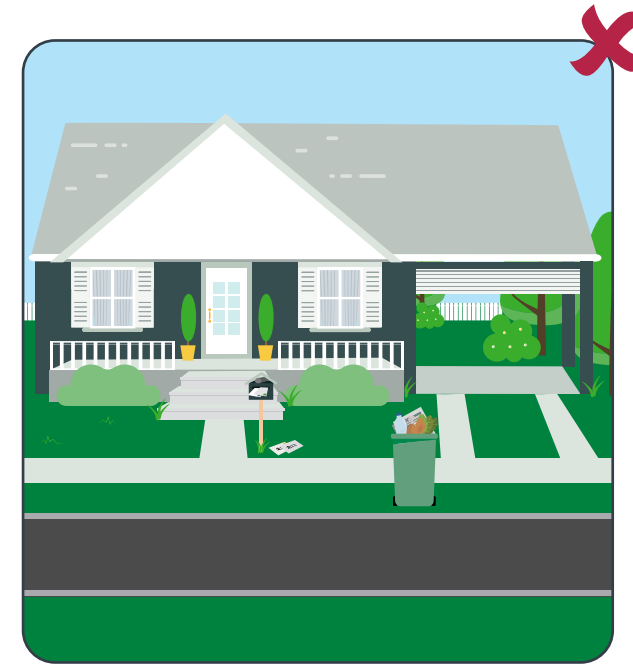
Report all thefts and break-ins to the Police



Do not leave spare keys hidden at the house



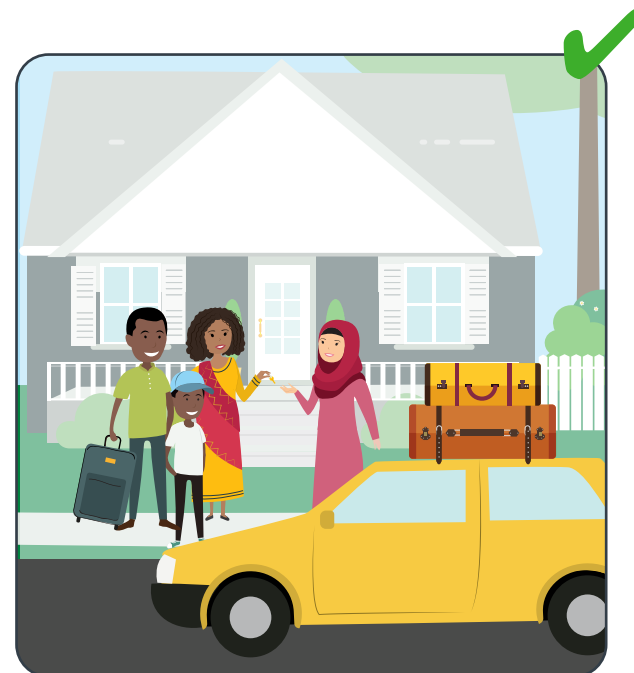
Do not leave windows and doors unlocked



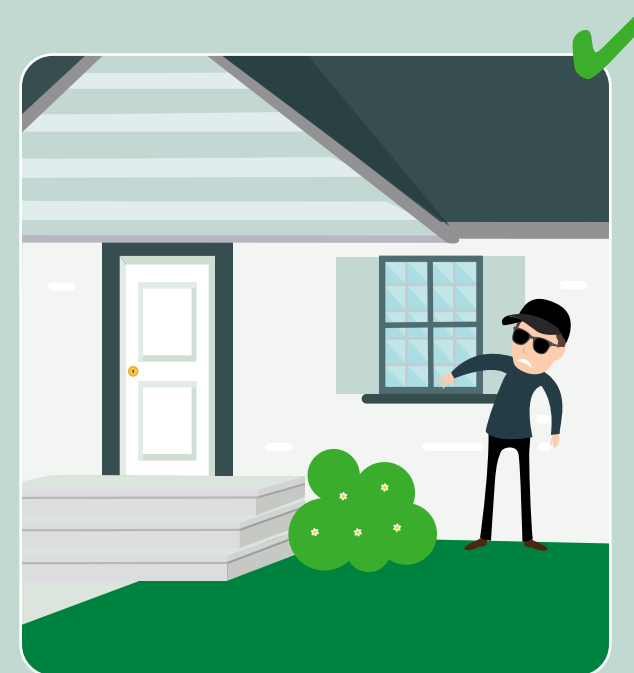
If you are away get someone to check your mail, mow your lawn and put your bin away



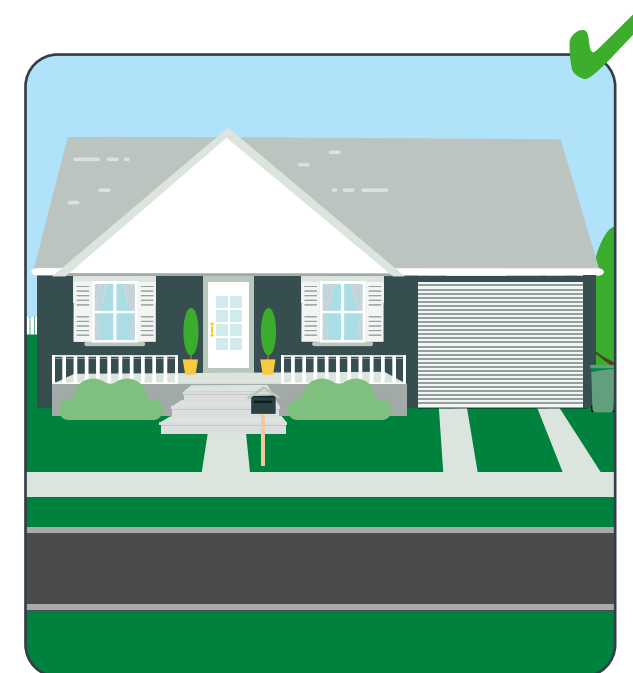
Take photos of all valuables and keep a record of serial numbers
